MISSIONARY UPDATE

I have some good news to pass along to you. Most of us could use some good news these days. Things in our world are certainly dark. And few people know more about the darkness of evil than our brothers and sisters in South Sudan. I've written to you on so many occasions about the tragic state of the young nation. But the followers of Jesus who are the Evangelical Church of South Sudan are persevering and doing Jesus' work amidst a tsunami of troubles. They know what Jesus told us--that the Kingdom of God will face massive resistance.

So what is this good news?

- Baptisms - New Christ-followers are celebrating their "resurrection" from death to new life in the Nile River
- Children are loved and introduced to Jesus in Juba churches. It's impossibly difficult to be a kid in a war zone. But the children being loved in the ministries of ECSS are given the opportunity for a better life with Jesus and his people-- and they get nourishing food
- New Juba church building has doors (hopefully they will soon be open to all)
- Masters degree students who are studying Spiritual Formation with George at University of Juba have just completed a unit of study on "Forgiveness and Reconciliation." What I read in their reflections were amazing testimonies of the power of Jesus to forgive and to enable His followers to forgive.
