PLEASE be PRAYING for DONDRA. Early in January, Dondra had a hernia surgery. It all went well and recovery was taking place. But last week, she began to have stabbing pain in her side. At first, the doctors attributed it to the healing process. But as the week progressed, the pain increased. By Saturday afternoon, we were in the ER. It was determined that something unrelated had been triggered by the hernia operation. After a couple of CT scans, the surgeons determined that an Intussusception of the intestine (where one section of the intestine telescopes inside another one) was taking place and it was not self-resolving. Surgery was done on Sunday evening and what they discovered was a "small mass" that was the cause of the pain. Of course, it was removed and we are waiting for the pathology report.

Ironically, if the hernia operation had not occurred, this mass would have probably remained undetected for many months or years making it a larger and more dangerous issue. It is good to know that we serve a God who does all things well!

We are praying for a great outcome from the pathology report. Please join us in that.
