MISSIONARY UPDATE

"AGS"

Millions in Muslim and Hindu communities are still asking the same question found in Job: "How can a person be made right with God?" The answer is found only in Jesus Christ— crucified and risen. This urgency compels us to go, share, and sow the seed of the Gospel faithfully.

A glimpse of God's work through your partnership:

- Easter Outreach (April 4): Over 100 Hindu and Muslim families got Easter / Jesus video gift cards— seeds of hope planted in receptive hearts.
- December Praise Report: Year-end mission outreach gatherings opened doors for new relationships; several families heard the Gospel for the first time and requested continued fellowship.

Teaching & Evangelism (Jan–Mar):

- Equipped students at Hawthorne Christian Academy on World Religions.
- Trained 55 students in a Perspectives class on reaching Muslims.
- Led outreach with Timothy Christian School students—engaging Hindus and Muslims at Oak Tree Road through conversations, literature, and prayer.
- Invited to multiple Ramadan gatherings—building bridges and sharing the truth of Christ in love.

International Impact:

Transforming lives where the Gospel is most needed

- School: new academic year began with strong enrollment and grateful parents, affirming excellence in education, care, and witness.
- Children Churches: 900 children from 28 locations gathered, joyfully proclaiming Christ during Palm Sunday celebrations—a powerful testimony in a challenging environment. Just as Jesus washed His disciples' feet, pastors humbly washed the feet of children, churches pastors, and teachers—modeling Christ-like humility for families and communities to follow.

Urgent Needs & Opportunities:

Bring freedom, dignity, and the Gospel to those in deep need.

- Sponsor 22 Children Churches – \$1,500 per church annually
- Release 7 families from brick kiln slavery – \$3,400 per family
