- Sewing Class The Fall class went well. Dee Dee plans to start the next one at the end of February. The ladies love improving their sewing skills and seem to enjoy and benefit from the devotionals.
- ☐ E –invited Klint (our son-in-law) and I to attend a talk with him on Muhammad a local university. It was hosted by the university's I\$lamic students group. Afterward, the three of us talked at length with the speaker about issues raised in the talk. It was a good evening.
 - E has resisted reading the Bible for years but finally agreed to read a gospel. I suggested Luke. He said. "No. I think I'll read Mark instead, since it probably came first." Fair enough. So he has now read about 5 verses in Mark, which seems like nothing. But since it quoted from Isaiah and Malachi, he decided to read the 8 chapters of Malachi and a good portion of Isaiah (as background, if you will!). Then he started reading 1 Kings, saying "because I want to learn more about the prophet Elijah." Next, he started reading Hebrews since, in answering one of his questions, I had mentioned something in Hebrews. Finally, he said, "I need to stop reading Hebrews and get back to Mark, but Hebrews is juicy!" (his words). So it has finally happened. He is actually reading the Bible— even devouring it. I see him as being like the rich young ruler who came to Jesus. A miracle is needed for him to come to the Lord. Please continue to pray for
