

MUTUAL SERVICE EPHESIANS 5:21-33 5.18.2025

MORNING SERVICE

Marriage and Family: Mutual Sacrifice

Ephesians 5:21-33 (page 919 of the pew Bible) | Dr Alfonse Javed

In Ephesians 5:21-31, we discover God's vision for marriage and family built on the divine principles of mutual submission, sacrifice, and service.

1. Mutual Submission

Christian marriage is Spirit-filled mutual submission to God and each other. To avoid misinterpretation, misunderstanding, and misuse of submission, Paul shows three truths about submission:

A. The Meaning of Submission

"submit (Gr: hupotassomai)" military term: to arrange oneself under another
 Mutual submission in the church allows all parts to function properly to honor Christ, maintain unity, and confront Satan, the enemy of the church and marriage

B. The Motivation for Submission

(v22-23)

just as soldiers arranged themselves in a formation to confront an enemy in the battle, wives are commanded to arrange themselves under their husbands to confront the enemy the husband needs his wife's support and aid

C. The Manner of Submission

(v24)

the wife's submission to her husband excludes anything that is in opposition to Christ and the Word of God

Application Be filled with the Spirit. We cannot submit to Christ or each other without the Spirit Appeal Learn to submit to Jesus first.

Action Step Discuss in Small Groups. Come back to hear the rest of the series.

2. Mutual Sacrifice

(v25-30)

Paul draws a connection between Christ's love for us, the church, and the way husbands ought to love their wives. Paul shows three facts about love:

A. A Commitment to Selfless Love

(v25)

Husband should love their wives like Christ loved the church; agape love unconcunchanging, and sacrificial irrespective of the actions of the object of that love

Application Husbands, loving your wives has very little to do with how you feel and everything to do with what you do to show sacrificial love for her. Love is an action verb.

B. A Command to **Sanctifying** Love

Husbands are to protect against impurity, prevail against immorality, and persevere

Application Husbands, you are responsible for sanctifying your wives by obeying and applying the Word of God in all areas of your life, including marriage and family.

C. A Conviction for Sustaining Love

(v28-30)

Husbands are to do everything in their power to sustain themselves and their wives for their marriages because they both belong to the same body, the body of Christ.

Application Husbands, love your wives with a sacrificial, selfless, and sustaining love. Appeal Teach your children so they understand God's design and vision for marriage and family Action Step Make Jesus the standard for loving others, especially in marriage and family.
