We came to the conclusion that she is a con artist and believe she is from Romania. Although she claimed to be alone and without anybody to help her; there was a man waiting in a vehicle the whole hour and a half that she was with us and she lived 1.5 hours away from our church. Even though this lady planned on scamming our church, God meant it for good because she ended up hearing the Gospel clearly that morning, we prayed with her, gave her gospel tracts to read at home (had a Bible at home) and we invited her to come back with her family any Sunday. We did give her some gas money and some homemade tamales made by one of the ladies in the church. You never know what a Sunday will bring!
